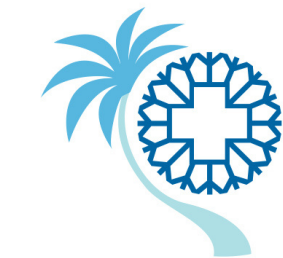

PLEASE NOTE: A patient's care team may make compassionate exceptions, when appropriate. All visitors must wear mask, and sanitize their hands. Visitation guidelines are subject to change.

*Special assistance is any circumstance where a patient's care team determines that a visitor is critical to physical or emotional care.

**Children must be accompanied by an adult (18 years of age and above), not the patient watcher/designated caregiver. Age restrictions for influenza season may be put into place at the direction of the Infection Control Officer and Administration. Duration of visit for infants and toddlers under 3 years of age is limited. Children 2 years and older must wear mask at all times.

***Up to 4 visitors will be allowed every hour. No switching regardless of level of care. No children below the age of 12 years old.
